Judging for Clothing Construction, Clothing Construction Style Revue, and Clothing Buymanship is scheduled for Monday, July 15 at the Ford County Fairbuilding. All clothing construction, style review & buymanship entries must be pre-entered by July 1, 2019. All garments and items judged on Monday, July 15 must be brought to the Fairgrounds on Thursday, July 18 by 10:00 a.m. for exhibition, and to receive comment sheets and ribbon placings. A clothing tag, available in the Extension Office must be on all articles.

Please complete the style revue description form and evaluation scorecard. You may return both to the Extension Office prior to Friday, July 12 or bring them with you on the day of judging. Forms must be submitted before 9:30 a.m. on Monday, July 15. TAKE TIME TO WRITE A DESCRIPTION THAT CAN BE READ AT THE PUBLIC REVUE. BE CREATIVE AND USE YOUR IMAGINATION. EXAMPLES ARE ON THE FORM. This year, I am giving an option of e-mailing your style revue description to me and we can then copy it into the script. Please print off a copy and attach it to your paper entry also. E-mail description to eschnewe@ksu.edu.

On the Evaluation Scorecard, you need to complete the top half and the judges will complete the bottom. Only youth in the senior category will need to complete the "cost per wear" form.
